The article for the conference should be based on original research, propose new ideas, and meet technical requirements.

Requirements for articles:

- Structure
Title, brief information of the author, abstract, keywords, the article, and bibliography.
- Article subject
The subject should be written in Mongolian and English in capital letters.
- Abstract
The article should be in either Mongolian or English. The abstract should be in English.
- Citation
APA style.
- Article size
A4 size 8-12 pages. (Pages will be numbered).
